<u>COURSE MAP</u> for Woodbank Park, Stockport will be posted next week under "MACCL-Course Maps & Venue Notes" on the website <u>www.manchesterareaccl.com</u>. Please note this is not the usual venue for Match Two.

<u>MATCH ONE</u> Total number competing was 784 broken down as follows: JUNIORS U13 to U17: 229 completed their races against 206 in 12/13, 192 in 11/12 and 181 in 10/11. WOMEN: 212 completed the Women's race against 187 in 12/13, 171 in 11/12 and 158 in 10/11. MEN: 343 completed the Men's race against 351 in 12/13, 363 in 11/12 and 297 in 10/11. It was a warm, sunny day and conditions were good. Many thanks to Manchester Harriers & AC for hosting the Match and to the Officials for their continued help and support. Entries total 1,667 (Juniors 518; Women 390; Men 759).

NB: Anyone wishing to take photographs or videos on Match Day must first sign in at Registration. This is a child protection policy with which we are obliged to comply.

VIDEO As advised, a short promotional video of Match One was made and will be available to view on YouTube soon. It's a representation of the League and shows what happens on Match day. We're sure you'll enjoy it. I'll post details on the home page of the website as soon as it's available to view – www.manchesterareaccl.com.

<u>RACE NUMBERS</u> have been allocated for the whole season. There are three basic sets: white background starting at No. 1 for Boys & Girls U11, U13, U15, U17; yellow background starting at No. 1 for Senior, U20 & Veteran Women; blue background starting at No. 1 for Senior, Under 20 & Veteran Men. Most of the numbers for those pre-entered were collected by the Team Managers at Match One. It is the responsibility of the Clubs to ensure their runners have the correct number for each match. Remember, the number allocated is the number for all five matches so keep your number safe, bring it to each match and remember safety pins! Remember too that there is a 50p charge for replacement, handwritten numbers! You risk disqualification if you race in a number not provided by the League.

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ENTRIES As advised, the League will accept late entries but please help us by sending them at least 48 HOURS BEFORE EACH RACE. PLEASE DON'T LEAVE IT UNTIL RACE DAY.

We will accept entries on race day <u>FROM TEAM MANAGERS</u> but that facility is meant for special circumstances when you really didn't know that a runner was going to compete. Race day entries do cause more work and can be the cause of frustration if a queue forms! <u>INDIVIDUALS SHOULD CHECK WITH THEIR CLUB TO SEE IF</u> <u>THEY HAVE BEEN ENTERED AND MUST ENTER THROUGH THEIR TEAM MANAGER</u>.

So, Team Managers should contact the ENTRIES CO-ORDINATOR, JULIE LAVEROCK, by email or by telephone at least 48 hours before each race. Numbers will then be ready for collection on race day. Individuals should contact their Team Manager (your Club will know who he/she is). **Entries from individuals will not be accepted.**

Individuals please note – you risk not being able to compete if you don't enter through your Team Manager so get yourself sorted in good time.

An updated list of those already entered will be posted on the website this weekend and additional entries will be posted on the 2^{nd} November and again on the 7^{th} .

COMPETITORS PLEASE NOTE the following when finishing a race.....

- > stopping your watch as you cross the finish line obscures your number
- *do not leave the finish funnel mid-way along*
- > stay in finish order to the end of the finish funnel
- keep walking through the finish funnel (unless a judge recorder requests otherwise)
- do not stop to talk to fellow competitors until you have left the funnel
- if you have a query about your finish place or time bring it to the attention of the Race Referee please don't interrupt the judge recorders and timekeepers.

<u>Don't forget</u> there will be a **Merit Award** and a **Raffle** at the end of this season – see notes on the website. There's also great news about the **Presentation** of Awards as this will take place in Wythenshawe Park - full details will be posted on the website very soon.
