SCORING IN THE EVENT OF A TIE – TEAMS *[applies to INDIVIDUALS too]*

Taking the best 4 races, if one team finishes higher 3 times, that team wins. If both teams finish higher twice, the positions of the last counting runners in each of the 4 races will determine the winning team. For vet teams the positions gained in the vet race are used. (*Last counters are shown after the points.*)

The number of achievable points is determined by the number of competing teams. For example, there were 54 Snr Mens teams in Match One, 10 of whom are in Division One leaving 44 for Division Two. Forty-four is therefore the number of points awarded to the first team. If more teams finish in subsequent matches, the number of points will be changed accordingly and the previous match points will be updated. If fewer teams compete, the points do not change.

SENIOR & VETERAN TEAMS - *there are two divisions for both the Senior and Veteran Teams but there are now enough teams (even taking into account that the number of teams is likely to drop as the season progresses) to consider having three or even four divisions next season. If that were to happen, the final positions this season would determine the division in which the teams would start the new season. So, do bear that in mind. The chart gives the number of teams in Division 2 to-date.*
